

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF A BUILDING PERMIT

California Building Code Section 105.5, as amended by Calaveras County, states the Chief Building Official may extend the time for action on a building permit for a period not exceeding 180 days if requested before the application has expired. The applicant must show that circumstances beyond the control of the applicant prevented action from being taken. In order to review action on a building permit after expiration, the applicant shall resubmit plans and pay new plan review and permit fees.
