This news bulletin is intended to update the regulated community regarding the new Onsite Sewage Department Fee Schedule, status of Assembly Bill 885 regulations and intention to redraft the Onsite Sewage Disposal Code regulations as adopted by Board Resolutions 92-259, 93-45 and 94-195.

Onsite Sewage Department Fee Schedule

On September 2, 2008, the Calaveras County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 08-202 updating the Calaveras County Onsite Sewage Department fees. The new fee schedule replaces fees that were last established for the Department in 2007. Fees were established using the Department's weighted hourly rate of \$77.00/hr. The following schedule is provided for your review and information:

Assembly Bill 885 Update

Our February 19, 2008 news bulletin depicted the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) as being released in April of 2007. As of the writing of this newsletter the:

1. Rule will be published in the Office of Administrative Law on Nov 7, 2008. The web site to check for this is:

The Rule will contain the DEIR and Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirement.

2. There will be a 90 day public comment period with a series of public workshops held throughout the state between January and February. While these dates are tentative, and exact locations have yet to be determined, it is our understanding that the State Water Resources Control Board is going to try to hold to them at the following locations and times:

Redraft of the Local Onsite Sewage Disposal Code

The rules and regulations as adopted by Board Resolutions 92-259, 93-45 and 94-195 remain in the process of being updated. An initial draft is currently being reviewed by staff. While staff has taken some informal input from consultants, the Department will request further input from the regulated community at a date and time yet to be specified prior to taking the revised document to the County Board of Supervisors for consideration.
